They will be shutting down RISK on June 16, 2014 and all incidents reports will need to be done on paper until July 1, 2014 when Restore goes live. Guy Krause

Guy stated that the agencies need to get their ESMTs and PSMTs entered in a timely manner and make sure that the ESMTs have been entered when PSMT changes are approved.

Legislation was passed changing calculation of Correction Officer I/II's to overtime from daily to weekly.

FY 2015 pay plan has RNs and a few other classes set for class specific increases effective July 1, 2014 and the statewide 1% increase to be effective January 1, 2015.

FY 2016 preliminary pay plan has 1.8% structure change and 1 – 2 step within grade effective January 1, 2016.

There was \$300,000 put into OAs budget for a Compensation Study.

Statewide Policy Committee Update

The FMLA rule changes and Bereavement Leave guidelines have been drafted and the committee will let us know if accepted.
